


How is Ikaika Ohana related to ALICE?

- We develop workforce housing
- Housing for anyone that works but cannot afford housing
- The majority of what we develop is for households below 80% AMI

How do we find our way?




- 1. Will

- Federal, State, County, and Agency guidance creates mandates
- Mandates create processes

- Planning helps create workforce housing
